BACKGROUND TO THE STUDY AND BASKET CONTEXT

- The benchmarking study was originally initiated by TRA Bahrain in 2008 and has been updated on approximately an annual basis since then. This update for 2020 was commissioned by TRA Bahrain.
- In increasingly competitive markets it is important for regulators to be able to track the evolution of prices and analyze the impact of price changes and competition on the effective prices paid by consumers.
- This study allows Arab countries to compare the price levels within and between countries, and also to compare with the OECD countries. To enable such comparisons, this study shows the cost of purchasing ‘baskets’ of telecommunications services. Additionally, time series data is presented, showing how the cost of such baskets has changed in each country over the period from 2016 to 2020.
- The benchmarking covers the following services:
 - Fixed voice (PSTN)
 - Mobile telephony
 - Fixed Broadband
 - Mobile broadband
 - Leased Lines

Leased line basket results were excluded in the 2019 report, but have been reintroduced at the request of AREGNET members.

- The basket methodologies used are identical to the OECD Price Benchmarking baskets from 2017, with minor changes. A separate document detailing the methodology used in this study is available.
- The data was collected in July/August 2020 by Teligen from public sources on the Internet, and was subsequently passed to national regulators for comments and checking.

2020 STUDY OVERVIEW

- The 2020 AREGNET study results are presented in this report. As in previous years, the study benchmarks fixed and mobile voice and data services across the 22 AREGNET countries
- In terms of data collection and verification:
 - Data was collected directly from operator websites over the period July/August 2020
 - Country data files and draft results in local currencies were prepared and distributed to AREGNET members for review
 - Following receipt of comments, system files were finalised and reports prepared
- The methodology used is based on the 2017 OECD basket revisions, which also featured in the 2019 update to this study. Full details of the OECD 2017 methodology are available, but key changes over the OECD 2010 methodology include:
 - Removal of international calls from fixed voice baskets
 - Revision of mobile baskets, with sets of baskets focusing on low and high data usage separately, with increased data usage in the high data usage category
 - Revision of speed categories for fixed broadband services, including removal of upper speed limit within individual baskets
 - Revision of data usage within mobile broadband services.

NOTES TO THE RESULTS


- Due to the change in baskets, results in this update are not necessarily comparable to previous reports
- For time series comparison, however, the new baskets have been applied retrospectively, to produce historic results based on the current (new) baskets.
- As with previous updates, exchange rate and CPL (comparative price level) current data is applied retrospectively to historic data, so that changes to time series reflect changes to tariffs only, and are not impacted by changes in either exchange rates or CPLs.
- For this report, both OECD country results and AREGNET country results have been adjusted using World Bank CPLs. This is different to previous reports, where OECD results have used OECD CPLs and AREGNET country results have been adjusted using World Bank CPLs
 - This means that both sets of data – OECD and AREGNET – are based on conversions from the same source
 - Note however, OECD results converted using World Bank CPLs will not be directly comparable to official OECD results.
- Feedback, where received, has been taken into account in the production of these results

COMPARATIVE PRICE LEVEL (CPL) AND PURCHASING POWER PARITY (PPP)

- The data presented in the report is presented using purchasing power parities (PPPs), which are used to incorporate both the financial differences between exchange rates, and the differences in the state of the economies as seen through the purchasing power of the citizens in each country.
- In order to create an up to date PPP conversion factor, published Comparative Price Level (CPL) data is used
 - This is described in more depth on pages 164 to 166, in the appendix of this report.
- The CPL data used for this study has been obtained from the World Bank, and is based on 2019 data.
- For this report, both OECD country results and AREGNET country results have been adjusted using World Bank CPLs. This is different to previous reports, where OECD results have used OECD CPLs and AREGNET country results have been adjusted using World Bank CPLs
 - This means that both sets of data – OECD and AREGNET – are based on conversions from the same source
 - Note however, OECD results converted using World Bank CPLs will not be directly comparable to official OECD results.
- The World Bank CPL data also contained some gaps i.e. data for Palestine and Somalia was not available, so assumptions were made as to the likely CPL values for these countries
- The PPP values have been applied retrospectively to any historic data presented in this report
 - This is to ensure that any changes observed in the time series are as a result of changes to tariffs and not to exchange rates and CPL values.

PRICE BENCHMARKING WITH TELECOMS BASKETS

Combine tariff information with a usage profile in a “basket calculation engine” to calculate cost of individual calls and tariff elements.


- Tariffs from the incumbent operator in each country
 - Several tariff packages can be covered for each operator
 - The results show the lowest cost option for each operator
- Tariff information included in basket calculation:
 - Fixed charges for installation (depreciated over the service life) and monthly rental. These are shown on the following charts as **Fixed charges**
 - Usage charges covering local through to national calls and calls to mobiles. These are shown on the following charts as **Fixed to Fixed calls** and **Fixed to Mobile calls**.
 - International calls are now **no longer** part of the OECD methodology and have been excluded from the baskets












- Comparison between OECD and Arab averages are shown on the following slide, however, the following can be observed:
 - The trend from previous updates continues for residential services. Most countries are either below the OECD average, or are on par with it, and the Arab average is consistently below that of the OECD average. Consequently, at this level of usage, the Arab average is below that of the OECD, between 10-24% cheaper.
 - Similarly for business services, most countries are above the OECD average, and the Arab average is consistently higher than that of the OECD, 28% for the 100 calls basket and 57% for the 260 calls basket..
- As in previous years, a number of the Arab countries in North Africa are cheaper than those in the Middle East, although as usage increases, operators in the Middle East become comparatively more competitive.
- Sudan, Egypt and Kuwait feature consistently among the cheapest for the residential baskets, while Tunisia, Djibouti and Morocco feature for the business baskets. In terms of the most expensive, Comoros, Morocco, Palestine and Saudi Arabia, are among the most expensive countries for the residential baskets, while for business, Mauritania, Kuwait and Palestine feature.
- A number of Arab countries continue to have fixed costs well below the OECD countries, causing the usage element to dominate. This makes the overall cost grow quicker with increasing usage, something that will discourage growth in usage. In some Arab countries, however, both fixed and usage costs are much higher than OECD countries.

* Countries with gaps in the tariff information are not considered.



COMPARISON OF OECD AND ARAB AVERAGES

Arab and OECD average comparisons for OECD fixed voice baskets



- For residential baskets, the Arab average is consistently lower than the OECD average
- For both business baskets, the Arab average is more expensive than the OECD average, with lower usage Arab businesses paying on average 28% more, and higher usage businesses paying around 57% more.

OBSERVATIONS FROM FIXED VOICE TIME SERIES RESULTS

- There have been very few changes to fixed voice from the 2019 update. The impact of the changes was generally very small, and in some cases, did not have any effect on the basket results
- The most notable price changes 2019-2020:
 - Saudi Arabia has increased VAT from 5% to 15% in reaction to the Covid pandemic, and this came into effect 1st June 2020. In Tunisia VAT has increased from 18% to 19%.
 - Batelco in Bahrain increased monthly rental to its plans but it now includes 100 on-net minutes.
 - Egypt Telecom changed its name to Telecom Egypt. There is an increase in connection charge for Telecom Egypt from previous update due to increase in stamps from EGP 6.1 + 1 (plus VAT) to EGP 8+ 2.9 (plus VAT).
 - Plans have not changed for Orange in Jordan but for residential plans included minutes have been corrected and surplus option have been removed as these are not picked up by the baskets.
 - New unlimited calls to fixed option added to Maroc Telecom tariffs.
 - For Palestine some adjustments have been made to the tariff to better reflect the pricelist.
 - In Qatar, the out of bundle rates for calls to the second operator were previously set to 0 but this has now been amended to show the call charges.
 - Saudi Telecom's Home Phone Plus now includes 100 anynet mobile minutes. For business Basic plan national call price has been corrected from previous update.
 - In Tunisia rental for business plans increases between updates.
 - Etisalat in UAE is not offering standalone fixed voice services to business.
- Average costs across all residential and business baskets have changed only slightly from previous year, very slight increases and decreases have been seen.

- Over the period 2016-2020, the trend continues with the average price not changing dramatically. However, lower usage residential basket costs continue to show small, gradual increases, and this is very typical, and often driven by increases in rental charges, with the biggest impact being seen for small usage baskets.



MOBILE TARIFF DATA ISSUES

- Tariff restrictions:
 - Only pre-paid for Comoros
 - One operator only for Comoros, Mauritania, Syria
 - No data for Djibouti and Somalia
- Otherwise two operators are covered for each country where data is available
- A total of 1073 tariff packages covered for 38 operators in 21 countries
- Results are presented for residential prepaid and postpaid offerings, in line with OECD methodology and in line with previous AREGNET studies
- The increase in data allowances across the OECD baskets for 2017 may result in very high costs for high data baskets in those countries where tariffs are not optimised for high levels of data use.





MOBILE VOICE AND DATA BASKETS, 2017 DEFINITIONS

- There are 12 baskets OECD baskets for mobile voice/mobile voice and data:
 - 2 baskets with no data
 - 5 baskets with lower data use
 - 5 baskets with higher data use
- Included in the OECD 2017 definitions are two unlimited voice baskets. Results for these have not been included due to the small number of providers that have unlimited offers.
















100 CALLS AND 2GB/MONTH BASED ON 2017 OECD MOBILE VOICE AND DATA BASKET




300 CALLS AND 5GB/MONTH BASED ON 2017 OECD MOBILE VOICE AND DATA BASKET



- A comparison between the OECD and Arab averages is shown in the next slide, both per country and per provider
- As in the previous year there is a clear correlation between the size of the basket (in terms of number of calls and volume of data), and the extent to which countries fall below the OECD average. For smaller baskets, more countries fall below the OECD average. This number steadily declines as the number of calls and the data volume increases. Similarly, as in 2019, the number of providers for which prepaid offers are the cheapest is at its highest for no and low data usage baskets, but this changes increasingly to postpaid tariffs as data usage increases.
- Generally, the average result for the Arab providers is consistently higher than the OECD provider average across all mobile voice baskets, and the larger the basket the greater the variation. For the 30 calls no data basket, however, both the per provider and per country Arab averages are only very slightly higher than the OECD averages.
- Baskets which incorporate handset data show a broad variation in price across the Arab providers. This is still true for 2020 and the price continues to rise for baskets with higher data requirements, again indicating that in a number of countries, high mobile data use is still prohibitively expensive, and consequently, mobile data use is probably more limited.
- Where data costs are shown on the graph, these refer to overage charges or data add-on packages, rather than data included in the basic voice tariff. Where overage charges are higher, this indicates a limited range of data options, and mobile handset data services are much less well established, and are geared only towards very modest use. Over time, these costs should fall significantly, as mobile data use becomes more commonplace, and operators offer more competitively priced tariffs with more data included.
- The average number of tariff packages offered by the Arab operators is up slightly from 27 per operator in 2019, to 28 per operator in 2020.



OBSERVATIONS FROM MOBILE TIME SERIES RESULTS


- There has been a general mix of decreases and increases over the period 2019 to 2020, the predominant change is one of decreasing prices, with more tariffs decreasing or remaining static than increasing from one year to another. In all baskets bar one, fourteen or more countries saw their results either go down or stay the same from the previous year.
- Across all the baskets considered, the Arab average decreased from 2019 to 2020, with larger decreases for baskets with higher calls and data.

- Most providers made changes to mobile pricing. Some of the changes that were observed include, but are not limited to the following:
 - Both ATM and Djazzy Algeria made comprehensive changes to their plans.
 - In Egypt both providers made numerous tariff changes, including a billing change.
 - AsiaCell and Zain in Iraq both made changes to their PAYG plans.
 - Zain in Jordan introduced new Go packages.
 - Oman Mobile and Ooredoo added new plans to their portfolios.
 - Vodafone in Qatar introduced new unlimited tariffs.
 - MTN in Sudan changed both postpaid and PAYG plans
 - Estisalat in UAE made changes to its Freedom plans
- Prepaid plans account for just over half of all plans, this is a similar proportion as in the previous year.

FIXED BROADBAND BASKET METHODOLOGY

- Research covering 394 fixed broadband residential and business service offerings from the incumbent ISPs* in 21 Arab countries
- Costs are derived using the OECD broadband basket methodology, and are based on the baskets that were defined by OECD in 2017, which consider a number of speed ranges and usage levels (15 in total). The baskets are shown in the table below. As most ISPs in the Arab countries do not offer services in the highest speed category, results for these have not been included (greyed out in the table).
- The technologies included are DSL, Cable and Fibre. Wireless technology has been excluded.
 - As of July/August 2020, four Arab countries had broadband services >1000 Mb/s; Jordan, Oman, Qatar and UAE for residential services, and for business services UAE is the only country offering tariffs at this speed. For comparison in the OECD nearly 90% of its member states now offer very high speed services at 1000 Mb/s and above.
 - Costs are shown separately for both residential and business services



FIXED BROADBAND DATA ISSUES

- Price data is not available for broadband services in Iraq (wireless services only) or Somalia.
- It has not been possible to verify the prices for Yemen, and for continuity, prices have been left at the 2019 level.
- In general, speeds have continued to rise since 2019, the slowest increase is in speeds above 1000Mb/s. The table below, shows an increase of 91% for services that have a minimum advertised download speed of 2 Mb/s or above, and the increase is 32% for those with speeds of at least 30 Mb/s.



- Speeds above 2 Mb/s are available in 20 of the 21 countries covered. Four countries offer speeds over 1000Mb/s which is up one country from previous year.
- The average speed for the Arab countries for the current update is just under 70 Mb/s.

Note: the average speed is a simple average across the packages, and does not take into account the distribution of customers across available plans. Information on customer distribution is not available, and hence a weighted average is not possible.




RESIDENTIAL FIXED BROADBAND VERY LOW SPEED OECD 2017 BASKET >= 0.25 MB/S




RESIDENTIAL FIXED BROADBAND LOW SPEED OECD 2017 BASKET >= 10 MB/S






RESIDENTIAL FIXED BROADBAND MEDIUM SPEED OECD 2017 BASKET >= 25 MB/S







RESIDENTIAL FIXED BROADBAND HIGH SPEED OECD 2017 BASKET >= 100 MB/S




BUSINESS FIXED BROADBAND VERY LOW SPEED OECD 2017 BASKET >= 0.25 MB/S






BUSINESS FIXED BROADBAND LOW SPEED OECD 2017 BASKET >= 10 MB/S








BUSINESS FIXED BROADBAND HIGH SPEED OECD 2017 BASKET >= 100 MB/S





- Egypt continues to feature prominently in the 'Cheapest' three for both residential and business users for many of the baskets. Palestine, Tunisia, Kuwait, Syria, Yemen and Jordan also feature in the top three for selected residential baskets. For business users alongside Egypt, Morocco, Lebanon and Jordan feature quite regularly in the top three. Most expensive countries for residential users are Syria, Algeria and Sudan, with Saudi featuring as the most expensive for the lowest speed basket. For business users, the most expensive countries varies a lot depending on minimum speed of the basket and data allowance, although Comoros, Djibouti, Oman and Yemen feature more than once.
- There has not been a change in the trend that the number of Arab countries that are below the OECD average depends on the speed of service, and, for some countries, on the usage level. Generally, however, the greater the speed, the greater the variation in cost between the Arab countries and the OECD average.
- The average Arab residential cost is still considerably higher than the OECD average or up to 5.2 times higher for the highest speed basket. For business services, the average is up to 8.1 times higher.
 - The residential figure continues to be skewed by particularly high costs in a number of countries, in particular, Algeria, Oman, Mauritania, Saudi Arabia Sudan and Syria. For business services, the Arab average is heavily skewed by a number of countries, including Algeria, Comoros, Djibouti, Oman and Yemen.
- In ten of the twenty one countries usage based tariffs are still prevalent, in some instances providers offer both usage based and flat rate tariffs. Usage based results appear in selected baskets fro Egypt, Libya, Oman, Sudan and Yemen. Usage based tariffs continue to be offered in many OECD countries, however, often it's limited to one provider with an country, and often for low usage tariffs.
- A notable promotional offer from Batelco in Bahrain was an increase in many of the speeds offered, at no additional cost to the user. At present, the promotion is only available until the end of February 2021, whereby speeds will return to the their pre-promotional levels (at least this is the indication at the moment). As the speed boosts are only promotional in nature, they cannot be included in the results, however, if they were taken into account, this would present a significant reduction in the basket costs for Bahrain.



- The average speed across all offers, all countries stands at around 69 Mb/s in 2020, with over 40% of services greater than or equal to 20 Mb/s.
- There have been changes for most providers in the current update. Some of the changes include:
 - Bahrain: New residential fibre plans and a fixed line service charge to broadband subscriptions have been added.
 - Egypt: New DSL residential plans have been added.
 - Jordan: New residential and business fibre plans have been added.
 - Kuwait: New residential DSL plans have been added.
 - Palestine: Monthly rental was reduced for DSL plans.
 - Saudi Arabia: New residential and business plans have been added, including both DSL and fibre plans.



OECD 2017 0.5GB BASKET







- Generally, Egypt, Sudan, Somalia, Morocco and Tunisia are consistently the cheapest countries, for both residential and business services. Yemen, Libya, Djibouti, Jordan and UAE are among the most expensive.
- The average for the residential service baskets in the Arab countries compared to the OECD average ranges from 14% more expensive, for the 0.5 GB short validity basket, to 80% for the 20 GB basket.
- For business services, the range is 54% (more expensive) for the 50GB basket, to 175% for the 1 GB basket.

OBSERVATIONS FROM MOBILE BROADBAND TIME SERIES RESULTS



- There have been price and service changes from around two thirds of the Arab providers since 2019, with revisions of portfolios and changes to data allowances. The table below shows the overall shift in the Arab average for each basket and speed category, for both residential and business services, with the general cost trend being downwards for all but a limited number of baskets.

- What is noticeable is that for almost all baskets, the Arab average has fallen since 2019. Only the residential lower allowances baskets (0.5 GB, 1 GB and 0.5 GB short validity) increased, and these were generally relatively small increases. For the larger baskets, the decrease was much more dramatic, illustrating how providers are increasing data allowances within tariff offerings.
- There were changes to prices from most providers. Some of the key changes include:
 - Algeria – changes from all provider, in particular to business pricing
 - Bahrain – updating of residential and business pricing, with the introduction of new offers
 - Egypt – new residential and business plans
 - Iraq – new plans
 - Jordan – replacing of 3G plans with 4G plans, or addition of 4G to portfolio. Small increases in rentals, larger in allowances
 - Kuwait – introduction of 5G pricing in addition to 4G
 - Lebanon – changes to allowances and rentals leading to general overall reduction, particularly for the higher usage baskets
 - Morocco – removal of some tariffs and options
 - Oman – fewer options for users, but also price reductions, and change in presentation towards add-on style data
 - Qatar - Introduction of 5G pricing
 - Saudi Arabia – price increase to reflect VAT increase on some tariffs. Reduction in number of plans available. 5G plans offered extensively.
 - Sudan – some changes to data allowances and general increase in prices.
 - Syria – some price increases for lower allowances
 - UAE – New business plans. Some increase in allowances for residential plans.

OECD LEASED LINE BASKET, 2010 DEFINITIONS

- The leased line 2010 baskets were unchanged in the 2017 OECD review, and the 2010 baskets defined in 2010 are still current
- Prices for 2 Mb/s and 34 Mb/s national circuits
- 6 specific distances are used:
 - 2 km, 20 km, 50 km, 100 km, 200 km and 500 km
- Each distance is weighted in order to calculate a **weighted average price for one circuit** as follows:

- The 2 bitrates are calculated and reported separately.
- Where the distances in the basket go beyond the country borders, the weights of those distances are attributed to the longest available tariff zone.
 - For example: In Bahrain a 2 Mb/s circuit costs BD 890 regardless of distance. The longest possible circuit distance in Bahrain is approximately 50 km. But the weights for 100 km (8%), 200 km (10%) and 500 km (8%) are still applied to this price as the price for the longest possible circuit in order to cover 100%.
 - This may bias the results for small countries with distance-sensitive prices in the sense that a relatively higher proportion of the circuits will be at maximum cost
 - Small countries with no distance pricing will be favoured by this scheme.
- For the Arab country price benchmarking three more bitrates are added, to the extent they are offered in the countries concerned:
 - 64 kb/s (formerly used in the OECD 2006 baskets) and 256 kb/s in order to cover a wider range of services relevant for the region, and 155 Mb/s to show the potential for future development.
 - The calculations for these speeds use the same weighted average price as for 2 Mb/s and 34 Mb/s respectively






64 KB/S OECD LEASED LINE BASKET RESULTS

256KB/S OECD LEASED LINE BASKET RESULTS






2 MB/S OECD LEASED LINE BASKET RESULTS





34 MB/S OECD LEASED LINE BASKET RESULTS





- For 2 Mb/s, four countries – Lebanon, Kuwait, Sudan and Algeria - have prices below the OECD average
- For 34 Mb/s, Lebanon and Algeria fall below the OECD average, Bahrain is slightly more expensive, but broadly on par, and UAE is significantly higher than the OECD average cost.
- Many of the Arab countries are quite small in size and this price comparison may give advantage to the tariff structure used in these small countries.

OBSERVATIONS FROM LEASED LINE TIME SERIES RESULTS

- Leased line prices were not reported in 2019, but were re-introduced in 2020. As a result, the time series runs for an extra year, from 2015-2020
- Prices have been generally stable over time with either no or only occasional changes to prices by operators.
- Over the period 2018 to 2020, the only changes were to prices were as follows:
 - Bahrain reduced the price for the 2 Mb/s basket, with the basket cost falling from USD PPP 4,685 excl. VAT to USD PPP 3,316 excl. VAT
 - Bahrain also stopped publishing offers for 64 kb/s and 256 kb/s services, but introduced pricing for 155 Mb/s services
- The cumulative effect of these changes was as follows:
 - Reduction in the average for 64 kb/s from USD PPP 516 excl VAT to USD PPP 482 excl VAT
 - Reduction in the average for 256 kb/s from USD PPP 1,120 excl VAT to USD PPP 1,081 excl VAT
 - Reduction in the average for 2 Mb/s from USD PPP 2,668 excl VAT to USD PPP 2,516 excl VAT
 - No change to the 34 Mb/s average
 - Reduction in the average for 155 Mb/s from USD PPP 30,288 excl VAT to USD PPP 27,359 excl VAT

SUMMARY OF MAIN FINDINGS FROM THE BENCHMARKING STUDY: FIXED VOICE TELEPHONY (1)

- The cheapest and most expensive countries throughout are shown in the table below, with an Arab/OECD average comparison shown alongside:



- The trend from previous updates continues for residential services. Most countries are either below the OECD average, or are on par with it, and the Arab average is consistently below that of the OECD average. Consequently, at this level of usage, the Arab average is below that of the OECD, between 10-24% cheaper.
- Similarly for business services, most countries are above the OECD average, and the Arab average is consistently higher than that of the OECD, 28% for the 100 calls basket and 57% for the 260 calls basket. As in previous years, a number of the Arab countries in North Africa are cheaper than those in the Middle East, although as usage increases, operators in the Middle East become comparatively more competitive
- A number of Arab countries continue to have fixed costs well below the OECD countries, causing the usage element to dominate. This makes the overall cost grow quicker with increasing usage, something that will discourage growth in usage. In some Arab countries, however, both fixed and usage costs are much higher than OECD countries.
- There have been very few changes to fixed voice from the 2019 update. The impact of the changes was generally very small, and in some cases, did not have any effect on the basket results
- Average costs across all residential and business baskets have changed only slightly from previous year, very slight increases and decreases have been seen.
- Over the period 2016-2020, the trend continues with the average price not changing dramatically. However, lower usage residential basket costs continue to show small, gradual increases, and this is very typical, and often driven by increases in rental charges, with the biggest impact being seen for small usage baskets

SUMMARY OF MAIN FINDINGS FROM THE BENCHMARKING STUDY: MOBILE VOICE TELEPHONY (1)

- As in the previous year there is a clear correlation between the size of the basket (in terms of number of calls and volume of data), and the extent to which countries fall below the OECD average. For smaller baskets, more countries fall below the OECD average. This number steadily declines as the number of calls and the data volume increases. Similarly, as in 2019, the number of providers for which prepaid offers are the cheapest is at its highest for no and low data usage baskets, but this changes increasingly to postpaid tariffs as data usage increases.
- Generally, the average result for the Arab providers is consistently higher than the OECD provider average across all mobile voice baskets, and the larger the basket the greater the variation. For the 30 calls no data basket, however, both the per provider and per country Arab averages are only very slightly higher than the OECD average
- Baskets which incorporate handset data show a broad variation in price across the Arab providers. This is still true for 2020 and the price continues to rise for baskets with higher data requirements, again indicating that in a number of countries, high mobile data use is still prohibitively expensive, and consequently, mobile data use is probably more limited
- The average number of tariff packages offered by the Arab operators is up slightly from 27 per operator in 2019, to 28 per operator in 2020.
- There has been a general mix of decreases and increases over the period 2019 to 2020, the predominant change is one of decreasing prices, with more tariffs decreasing or remaining static than increasing from one year to another. In all baskets bar one, fourteen or more countries saw their results either go down or stay the same from the previous year
- Across all the baskets considered, the Arab average decreased from 2019 to 2020, with larger decreases for baskets with higher calls and data.

SUMMARY OF MAIN FINDINGS FROM THE BENCHMARKING STUDY: FIXED BROADBAND (1)

- The average Arab residential cost is still considerably higher than the OECD average or up to 5.2 times higher for the highest speed basket. For business services, the average is up to 8.1 times higher.
 - The residential figure continues to be skewed by particularly high costs in a number of countries, in particular, Algeria, Oman, Mauritania, Saudi Arabia Sudan and Syria. For business services, the Arab average is heavily skewed by a number of countries, including Algeria, Comoros, Djibouti, Oman and Yemen.
- In ten of the twenty one countries usage based tariffs are still prevalent, in some instances providers offer both usage based and flat rate tariffs. Usage based results appear in selected baskets from Egypt, Libya, Oman, Sudan and Yemen. Usage based tariffs continue to be offered in many OECD countries, however, often it is limited to one provider with an country, and often for low usage tariffs
- As in previous years, the number of Arab countries that are below the OECD average depends on the speed of service, and, for some countries, on the usage level. Generally, however, the greater the speed, the greater the variation in cost between the Arab countries and the OECD average.
- The table below summarizes how the overall Arab average changed from 2019-2020. The picture is generally one of declining prices or relatively small increases. There have been changes for most providers in the current update

- Speeds have continued to rise since 2019, the slowest increase is in speeds above 1000Mb/s. The table below, shows an increase of 91% for services that have a minimum advertised download speed of 2 Mb/s or above, and the increase is 32% for those with speeds of at least 30 Mb/s.
 - Speeds above 2 Mb/s are available in 20 of the 21 countries covered. Four countries offer speeds over 1000Mb/s which is up one country from previous year.
 - The average speed for the Arab countries for the current update is just below 70 Mb/s which is down from previous year but still a huge rise from 2018.
- The table on the next slide shows the cheapest and most expensive 3 countries for each basket, along with a comparison of the Arab averages for each basket against the OECD averages

- The average for the residential service baskets in the Arab countries compared to the OECD average ranges from 14% more expensive, for the 0.5 GB short validity basket, to 80% for the 20 GB basket. For business services, the range is 54% (more expensive) for the 50GB basket, to 175% for the 1 GB basket.
- There have been price and service changes from around two thirds of the Arab providers since 2019, with revisions of portfolios and changes to data allowances. The table below shows the overall shift in the Arab average for each basket and speed category, for both residential and business services, with the general cost trend being downwards for all but a limited number of baskets. What is noticeable is that for almost all baskets, the Arab average has fallen since 2019. Only the residential lower allowances baskets (0.5 GB, 1 GB and 0.5 GB short validity) increased, and these were generally relatively small increases. For the larger baskets, the decrease was much more dramatic, illustrating how providers are increasing data allowances within tariff offerings

PURCHASING POWER PARITIES (PPP)

- PPPs are used to incorporate not only the financial differences between exchange rates, but also the differences in the state of the economies as seen through the purchasing power of the citizens in each country.
 - PPPs are based on an assessment of the price levels for a corresponding basket of goods and services in each country. i.e. how much the same basket costs in different countries.
 - PPPs are normally stated based on the US\$ or some other reference currency, e.g. Euro. This study uses the US\$ PPPs calculated by the World Bank.
- In order to update these values the Comparative Price Level (CPL) is used. CPL is the relationship between the PPP and the reference market exchange rate at the time the PPP was calculated.
 - CPL is used together with updated, i.e. current, exchange rates to produce an “updated” PPP value.
 - $CPL = \text{Rate}_{\text{PPP}} / \text{Rate}_{\text{Reference}}$
 - $\text{PPP}_{\text{Current}} = \text{Rate}_{\text{Market}} * CPL$
- The advantage of using PPPs is that the results reflect the price differences as seen by the end users in each country based on their income and other costs.

PPP BACKGROUND

- This benchmarking study relies on the PPP (Purchasing Power Parity) and CPL (Comparative Price Level) values produced by the OECD and the World Bank*. PPPs are used in international studies to provide a more even comparison between countries, adjusting the exchange rates to the purchasing power of the consumer in each country. CPL is used to calculate PPP values from current market exchange rates, in order to obtain the most up to date combination of PPP and market exchange rates.
- PPPs are usually expressed in US\$, referring to the US market. PPPs are produced comparing the cost of a basket of goods and services across countries
 - The World Bank defines PPP as: " ... the number of units of a country's currency required to buy the same amount of goods and services in the domestic market as a U.S. dollar would buy in the United States."
- The CPL is the ratio between PPP and Market Exchange Rate (XR) for a given country, as seen from a reference country (usually the USA).

$$\text{CPL} = \text{PPP}_{\text{US\$}} / \text{XR}_{\text{US\$}}$$

CPL<1 means goods are more expensive, CPL>1 means goods are cheaper, referring to the USA.

- The basket of goods and services is extensive, however, the PPP result will of course depend on the content of this basket. The OECD and the World Bank are working together to improve on the methodology to calculate the PPP.
- The World Bank implemented a new methodology for calculating the PPPs in 2011, improving the PPP results to show a more accurate ration between countries. The results of the implementation of this new methodology was seen in the previously published 2014
 - As the previous World Bank methodology was different to that used by the OECD, and the new World Bank methodology is now more aligned with the OECD methodology. The changes seen from the old to the new World Bank PPP values are smaller in OECD countries than in other countries of the world.

* The World Bank uses the term "Price Level Ratio" for the CPL.

Please note: Inverse values of PPP and CPL are also used, depending on application.

- Basket calculation: The process where the Basket is applied to the individual tariff in order to calculate the cost of the individual tariff elements and the overall cost.
- Basket result: The cost of using the service as described in the Basket.
- Re-balancing: The process through which the prices are changed so that individual Tariff elements will cover their own cost, and not subsidise other Tariff elements.
